Information sheet

What you should consider before and after a surgery on the face/skin

TO BE CONSIDERED BEFORE THE SURGERY:

- Avoid analgesics containing acetylsalicylic acid (ASA)
- Please do not wear make-up on the day of surgery and avoid using any face cream or other skin care cosmetics
- Please eat and drink enough before the surgery (no coffee)

TO BE CONSIDERED AFTER THE SURGERY:

- Please leave the wound dressing for 48 hours after the surgery. The first dressing change usually takes place in our practice.
- Please keep the dressing and the wound clean and make sure that it does not get wet
- In case of **postoperative bleeding**, please contact us! Outside office hours, in urgent emergencies at night or at the weekend, please contact the emergency room (Leipzig University Hospital, St. George Hospital Emergency Department)
- Please drink enough!
- Physical exertion (e.g. heavy lifting, sports), sauna visits and sunbathing should be avoided for up to 2 weeks after the surgery
- Please take the prescribed medication as medically advised
- Do not discontinue any prescribed medication after the operation without consultation, even if you are feeling well
- Do not drive your own vehicle after the surgery, reaction time may be reduced due to the local anesthetic
- If the swelling or pain continues to increase after the fourth day, please make an appointment with us for a check-up
- Certificates of incapacity for work may not be issued retrospectively. If you do not feel able to work at the end of your sick leave, please contact us!
